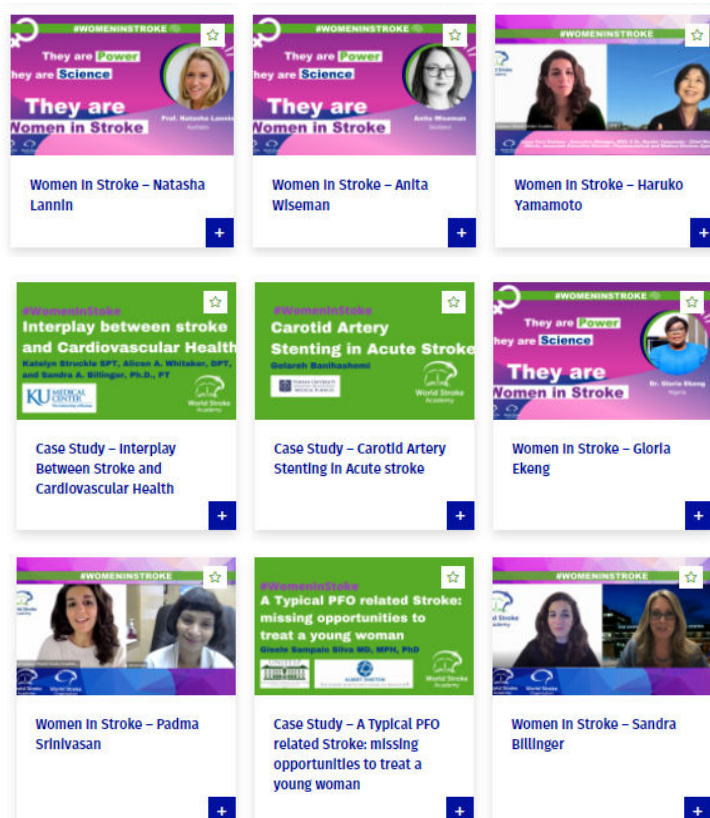


## #WomenInStroke 2022

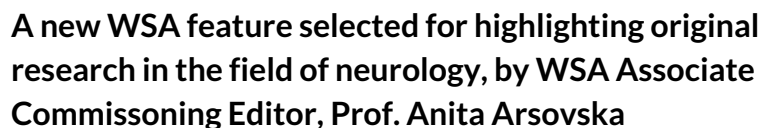
