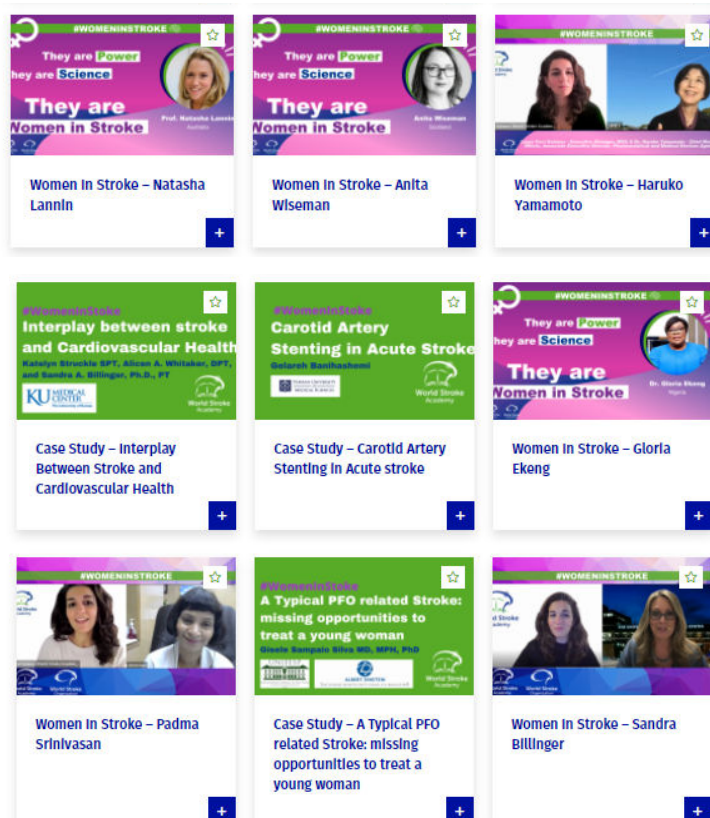


#WomenInStroke 2022
