## Thank you for joining us at ESOC 2022!

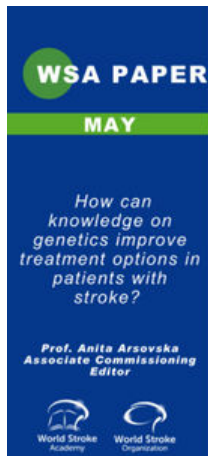
