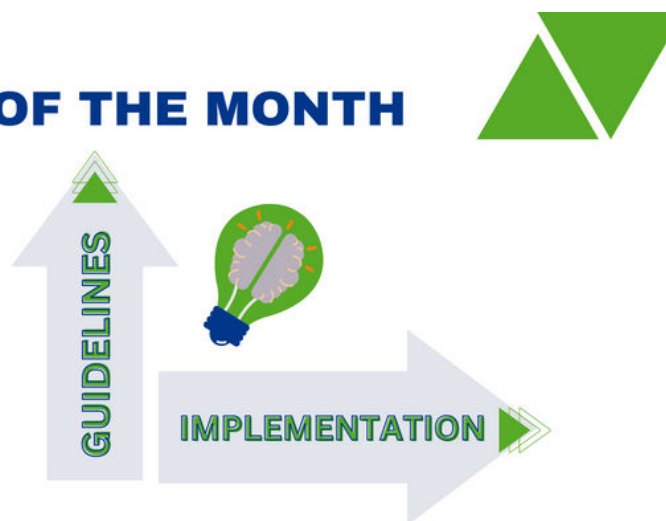

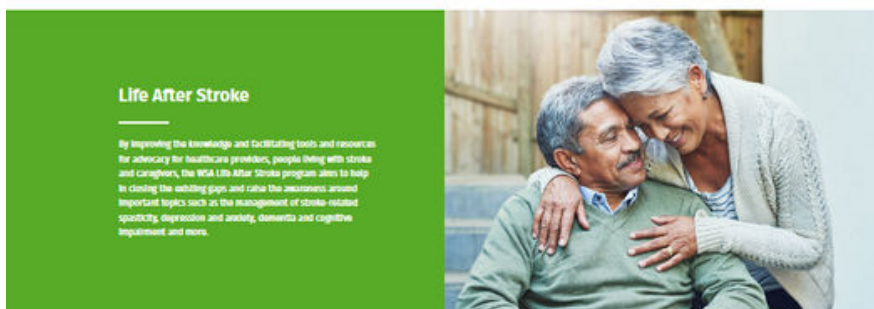
New #LifeAfterStroke page on the WSA site

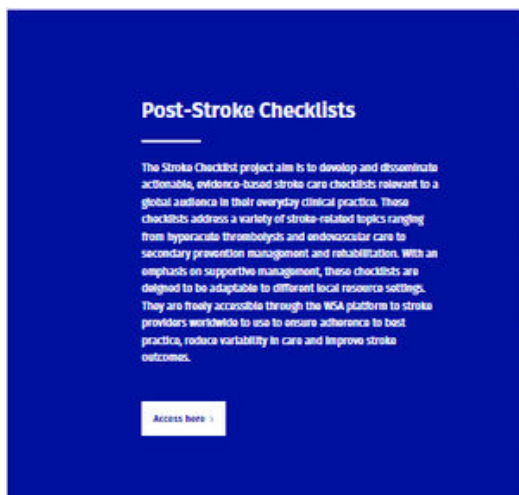

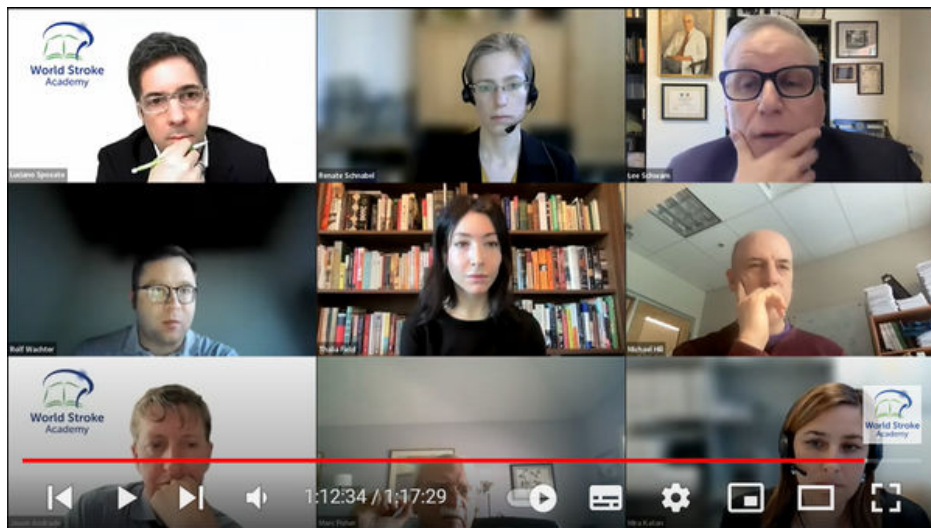

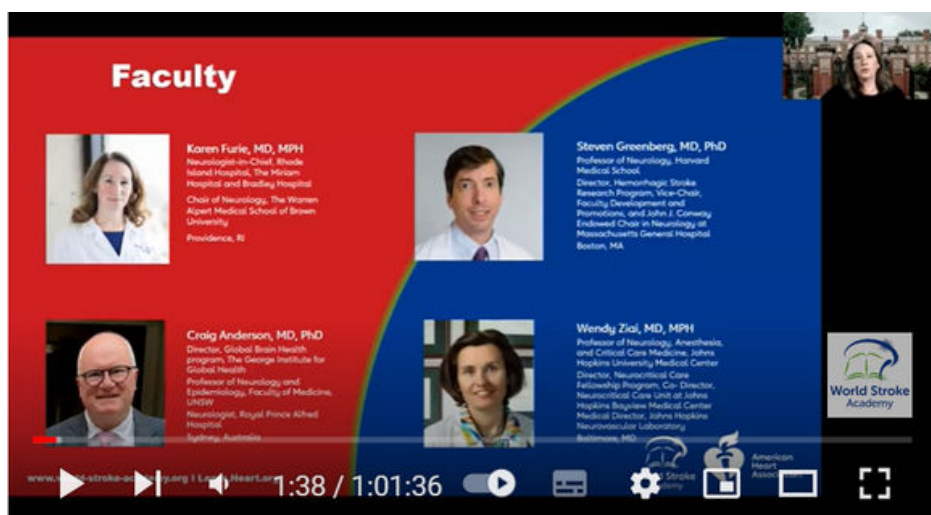
